### **PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT**

As representatives of Gloucestershire Cricket (junior and senior), you are expected to adhere to the following code at all times whilst on Gloucestershire Cricket duty:

- Enjoy the experience of playing for Gloucestershire Cricket Foundation and always try your hardest.
- Play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform your coach if you cannot play or you are going to be late.
- Wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coaches. The use of protective equipment (where relevant) is compulsory.
- Never smoke or vape whilst representing Gloucestershire Cricket at competitions or at practice sessions.
- Always leave the changing room in the condition you find them, whether playing at home or away.
- Gloucestershire Cricketers should never use their mobile phones in the changing room area.
- Never consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on whilst representing Gloucestershire Cricket.
- Never leave the ground on which you are training or playing without consent from your Team Manager/Lead Coach.
- Never bully or victimise a team-mate or an opponent, either in person or online.
- Never use foul or sexually explicit language on whilst representing Gloucestershire Cricket.
- Always challenge behaviour that you find unacceptable.
