Never has there been a better time to work in Cricket. In the ECB Strategy, Inspiring Generations, 'Engaging Children and Young People' and 'Supporting our communities' have been identified as two of the six priorities and it is now the requirement of County Boards to deliver on this.

With an increased investment from our main charitable partner, Chance to Shine, this position will have a focus on developing opportunities within schools for young people to participate, play and learn through cricket. In Gloucestershire we have a strong base in which to build from but there is still so much more that can be achieved and for this we are looking to appoint an outstanding individual to drive growth.

The GCF seeks to employ a highly motivated and competent Community Cricket Coach to support and work within the Cricket Development team. The role's main focus will be to increase participation whilst creating a network of 'cricket playing' schools that see cricket as part of their day-to-day activity. You will be expected to develop links to local clubs and support and lead on relevant competitions.

You will need to be passionate about, and committed to, cricket coaching at a local level and for this role, it would be an advantage if you have experience of cricket/sports development at a grassroots level coupled with a sound knowledge, appreciation and understanding of the game.

Candidates must demonstrate both team working skills and the ability to work unsupervised using their own initiative. You will be a self-starter with energy and enthusiasm together with good administration and organisational skills. Equally you will be an excellent communicator with a passion for the development of cricket/sport for young people.

The first step of the recruitment process is to complete a small number of preliminary, anonymised questions. We will then ask for CV's and covering letters to the candidates who we feel answered the questions to the standard we are looking for.
