Current areas of work: end of 2024:

Indoor leagues

We had 38 Women's teams enter the Women's Indoor league, with leagues being held in Bristol, Cheltenham/ Cotswolds, Gloucester/ FOD, and Stroud. For the first time, we also ran Girls indoor leagues this included 21 teams across 5 leagues.

Our W&G's committee

The committee is going from strength to strength with roles for each member being filled. When I started in my role, I discussed the future of the committee and how they want to see it developing, from this we have decided to bring a Women's and Girl's development group into the structure. As a group of volunteers, having extra hands and

voices to work through problems and set up fixtures/ manage the leagues, this new group will allow us to keep meeting the demands of our clubs.

County Women Seniors

We are in the process of starting a seniors side for the ladies. Having received interest from all over the county, Razi and I will be hosting a day for them to meet each other and work out which format of cricket will suit them best. From this day, we will set up regular training for them to attend and get some fixtures arranged with other counties.

Club Development

We had 2 clubs apply and successfully gain county grant funding for creating welcoming environments within the Women's and Girls game. Both of which are still helping to create positive experiences for their club members and opponents. A priority of the 2025 County Grant Fund will be to issue at least 75% of the total grants to clubs with Women and Girls' sections.

Lady Taverners - Schools

The competition saw 36 schools across the county, compete across 3 rounds of this Girls only schools offering. With our winners successfully heading onto the regional county finals days.
