The newly recruited Development Manager will have an exciting opportunity to lead on the women and girls' game and drive all aspects within the new 'Inspiring Gloucestershire 25-29' strategy. Specifically, the successful candidate will be responsible for the following areas of the game:

- Increasing the number of clubs with women and/or girls' sections.
- Maintaining and developing existing year-round women and girls' playing offers.
- Enhancing the delivery to girls in schools, both Primary and Secondary.
- Working with other Officers of the team to maximise investment in to producing facilities that are female friendly.
- Providing a participation pathway that continuously develops girls and women for County teams.

The Gloucestershire Cricket Foundation seeks to employ a highly motivated and competent Leader that will drive the women and girls' game and be a major player in the Senior Management Team. You will need to be passionate about, and committed to, the development of the women's and girls' game. Part of the role's focus will be working with traditional cricket partners, such as clubs and schools, however we would also expect the role to investigate new markets and partners to help drive participation to new audiences. With that in mind we are seeking an innovative individual who will bring enthusiasm and fresh ideas.

Candidates must demonstrate both team working skills and the ability to work unsupervised using their own initiative. You will be a self-starter with energy and enthusiasm together with good administration and organisational skills. Equally you will be an excellent communicator with a passion for the development of cricket.
