



Lottery Rules and Regulations

- All members and agents must be aged 18 years or over. No person under this age is allowed by law to enter the Lottery. Any person found to be under 18 years of age will have their stake returned and automatically forfeits the right to any prize. If prizes have already been paid out, all reasonable attempts will be made to recover them.
- All members will receive four lottery numbers for every £2 subscribed. Players may purchase more than one entry.
- All numbers will be entered into the draw on receipt of that week's subscription.
- No claim is necessary as all winners will be notified. The winners will be published on https://gloucestershirecricketfoundation.org/support-us/lottery-friends-of-the-foundation/results/
- There are no alternatives to any prizes and no interest is payable. Prizes will be sent within 14 days.
- No liability is accepted for the loss, theft or delayed receipt of any communication sent by post.
- The Lancashire Cricket Foundation (LCF) and Gloucestershire Cricket Foundation (GCF) reserves the
 right to use the winner's name for promotional purposes. These will only be in summary, e.g. Mrs
 Smith from London.
- 70% (£6.08 monthly DD or £72.80 annually) of the donation supports the GCF to continue to work
 across Gloucestershire and areas in Bristol, developing, delivering, and sustaining a wide range of
 school and community projects, programmes and events designed to engage, excite, inspire, and
 improve individuals through cricket. 30% of the donation (£2.60 monthly DD or £31.20 annually)
 goes to the LCF to manage and administer the lottery, marketing, the prize draw, and community
 activity.
